OVERVIEW

What do updates to LL87 require?

- Additional sorting step of recyclables3 Steps of Source Seperation:
 - 1. Waste
 - 2. Metal/Glass/Plastic
 - 3. Paper

NOTE: **NEVER** mix waste with recyclables

Metal, Glass, Plastic, and Beverage Cartons Metal Cans, Aluminum Foil and Bottles Rigid Plastic Mixed Metal/ Plastic Objects Beverage Cartons

What kind of recycling will be implemented?

» CO-COLLECTION Contracted waste hauler will pick up and process paper & metal/glass/plastic in one truck, and waste in another

NOTE: Your building has a stringent recycling program in place and DSNY will issue fines for non-compliance





REQUIREMENTS

What is required of tenants?

- » Tenants MUST comply with LL87 requirements:
 - Implementation of a 3-bin system to properly sort paper, metal/glass/plastic & waste
 - All bins must be clearly labeled stating the type of material that is being collected
 - Post and maintain signage in public, dining, pantry & maintenance areas instructing how waste and recyclables should be separated

What is required of SLG?

- Re-education of janitorial sorting and drop-off
 - Clear bags paper
 - Blue bags metal/glass/plastic
- Black bags waste
- » Standardize signange, decals, waste management policy and tenant materials across the portfolio
- » Work with buildings to configure loading dock
- » Notify tenants about proper compliance

NEXT STEPS

What is the best office configuration?

- » Suggested office waste-bin configuration:
 - Deskside bin for paper recycling
 - Metal/glass/plastic bin in pantry area
 - Waste bins in a centralized location
- » NOTE: SLG will **NOT** be providing additional bins, signage or labels. Links for purchasing options are found to the right
- » Bulk & e-waste pickup to be arranged separately
